**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

The 6”X7.5” map is a line-drawing of the continent of North America. It was published in 1813 by Longman, Hurst, Rees, Orme, and Brown in London. It shows the major mountain ranges as well as the major rivers east of the Rocky Mountains. The major rivers on both sides of the Sierra Madre system in Mexico are included. The large bodies of water shown from north to south and west to east include the Arctic Sea, Baffins Bay, Davis Strait, Hudson Bay, North Pacific Ocean, Gulf of Mexico, Atlantic Ocean, and Caribbean Sea. Lines of latitude and longitude are also on the map. The political regions from north to south and west to east on the map are Greenland, New Britain, New Albion, New Mexico, Louisiana, United States, California, New Navarre, and Cuba. Some cities are shown.
