### **SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

Applications to establish American Legion Posts 104 and 408 in Edinburg, Texas are included in this collection. Post 104 was also known as Mihiel Post. The application was dated November 10, 1919. Post 408 was designated as Edinburg Post. The application for that post is undated; however, the first and second endorsements are dated June 1926. The documents pertaining to the Edinburg Post are copies.
