BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Henry Jackson Ramsey (1874-1974) was the last Spanish-American War veteran in the Lower Rio Grande Valley, Texas. He was born in Mississippi on March 9, 1874 to John and Fannie (Hood) Ramsey. He enlisted in the Army on July 21, 1898 at Mineral Wells, Texas and served as a Private in Company D, Third Regiment of the Texas Infantry Volunteers. Ramsey was honorably discharged on January 11, 1899.

Around 1927 Ramsey moved to the Valley where he ran a contracting business. He constructed many of the buildings and residences in McAllen, Texas. He also was a post commander of the Rio Grande Valley Camp #24 United Spanish War Veterans.

Ramsey's wife was Alma. They had four sons (Travis, U.J., Cecil, and Sam) and two daughters (Euna Mae Caldwell and Mrs. Henry Erdmann). He died on January 10, 1974 and was buried in Roselawn Cemetery in McAllen, Texas.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Military papers and United Spanish War Veterans records make up the bulk of the Henry Jackson Ramsey papers. The military papers include a pension certificate and a certificate in lieu of lost or destroyed discharge certificate. The United Spanish War Veterans records consists of certificates, a roster for Camp #24, financial statements, legislative bulletins, annual reports, a telephone bill, a meeting agenda, and correspondence. Other United Spanish War Veterans materials include General Orders (a newsletter), pamphlets, and books.

Personal papers include a snapshot of flooding in McAllen, Texas; a letter (February 5, 1974) from E. (Kika) de la Garza, MC; page E307 from the January 30, 1974 *Congressional Record*; and an obituary.
