BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Felix L. McDonald was born on September 13, 1912 in Mexia, Texas to Mr. and Mrs. J.L. McDonald. The family moved to Edinburg when Felix was a child. In 1929, he graduated from Edinburg High School, where he excelled as a member of Professor George Hurt's famed Redshirt Band. In fact, Felix's class prophesied that he would one day succeed John Philips Sousa as director of the Marine Corps Band. McDonald's lifelong affable and energetic nature shone evident in his senior photo and the words of wisdom he left his fellow classmates: "Don't trouble trouble until trouble troubles you".

After attending Edinburg College, Felix McDonald moved to Austin to enroll in the University of Texas law school, from which he graduated in 1935. On August 21, 1937 he married Martha Jay Winn of Wharton, Texas. At the time he worked for Oliver Adrich's law firm in Edinburg. Shortly afterwards he began his public career in government by accepting the position of Delinquent Tax Attorney for Hidalgo County. In 1948 Martha and Felix adopted their daughter Jay Lynn.

On December 23, 1942, McDonald entered the U.S. Army and proceeded to officers candidate school at Fort Frances in Warren, Wyoming where he received administrative and personnel training. Upon completion of those courses, he was assigned to Fort Dix, New Jersey to serve as a hospital staff officer. Later the Army shipped him to Europe, where, as a legal officer, he served in northern France and Rhineland, Germany. He assisted displaced persons, managed banks, and investigated criminal cases. Following World War II, he continued serving in the Army Reserves, where he rose to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.

Meanwhile, in Edinburg, he continued working as an attorney specializing in probate law. He became Mayor of the city of Edinburg in April 1947, serving until April 1951. In April 1953 he began a ten year career as City Attorney. From 1955-1956 he served as president of the Hidalgo County Bar. He had served as president of the Kiwanis Club a decade prior and in March 1987 the Kiwanis awarded him the Legion of Honor.

He began his legislative career in the Texas House of Representatives during January 1963, eventually winning elections to the 58th, 59th, 60th, 61st, 63rd, and 64th Legislatures. Altogether he served twelve years, from 1963 to 1978, working in partnership with Bob Stewart in Edinburg. As a member of the Legislature, McDonald joined the Jurisprudence Committee and played an active role in the Texas Constitutional Convention Movement in the early 1970s. His legacy as a lawmaker was highlighted by a bill he sponsored that led to the creation of the Rio Grande Pollution Control Agency. He is also remembered for having helped transform Pan American College from its status as a locally funded institutions to Pan American University, a state institution. One of his last major efforts as a legislator was to merge Pan American University with the University of Texas, a merger that was finalized a few years after his death.

In 1970 Governor Dolph Briscoe appointed McDonald as director of the Texas Water Commission, where he served until 1983. In that capacity he was instrumental in obtaining passage of a law that established the Lower Rio Grande Water Conservancy District.

Felix McDonald lived in Austin until his death on August 16, 1987 at age 74.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Documents and photographs pertaining to both the career and personal life of Felix Lynn McDonald. The career documents are from his employment as an attorney, a member of the Texas House of Representatives, and as director of the Texas Water Commission. There is very little pertaining to his time as mayor of the city of Edinburg.

Personal documents include correspondence, materials from his marriage to Martha Jay McDonald and adoption of his daughter Jay Lynn McDonald.
